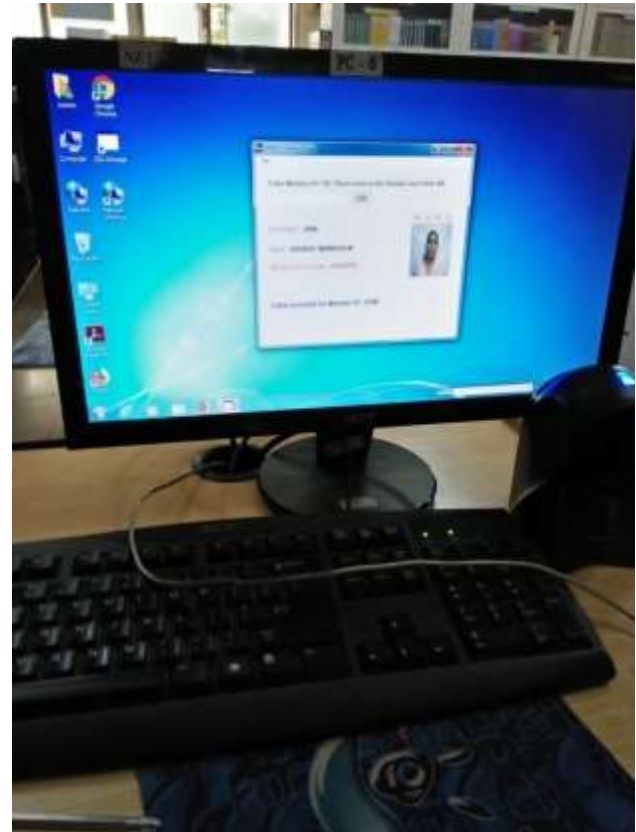
- Personal books & Journals are not allowed in the library .

Cost of Damaged / Lost books and Periodicals

- If issued book is lost or damaged by any user then the same book or later edition has to be replaced.
- If the lost book is not available anywhere in Mumbai then cost will be recovered in the following manner-
- If the book is published before 1985's then **5 times** cost of the book will be recovered.
- If the book is published in between 1986's – 2003 then **2 times** cost of the book will be recovered.
- However after 2004 publications **same cost** will be recovered.
- Periodicals are not taken out of the library.



Home

India is a country with a rich history and culture. Home to the Indus Valley civilization and a region of historic trade routes and vast empires, the Indian subcontinent was identified with its commercial and cultural wealth for much of its long history. Four major world religions, Hinduism, Buddhism, Jainism and Sikhism originated here, while Zoroastrianism, Judaism, Islam and Christianity arrived in the first millennium AD and mingled into the region's diverse culture. India became a modern nation-state in 1947 after a struggle for independence that was marked by widespread nonviolent resistance. The history of India can be divided into four major segments, the ancient era, the medieval era, the modern era and the post-independence era.

The hallmark of Indian history dates back to the stone age with paintings at the Rock Shelters of Bhimbetka in Madhya Pradesh. These paintings symbolise the earliest known traces of human life in India. The first known permanent settlements appeared over 9,000 years
